*But roses actually don't grow in February weather in the U.S. or Canada because it's too cold.*

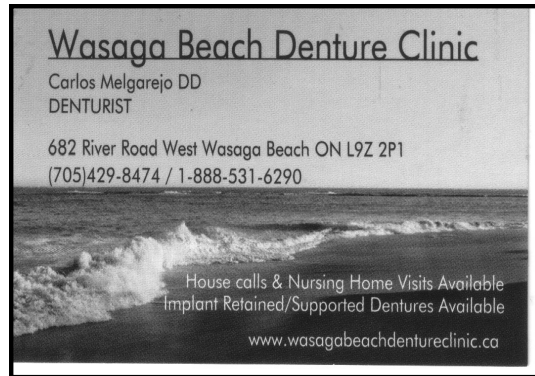
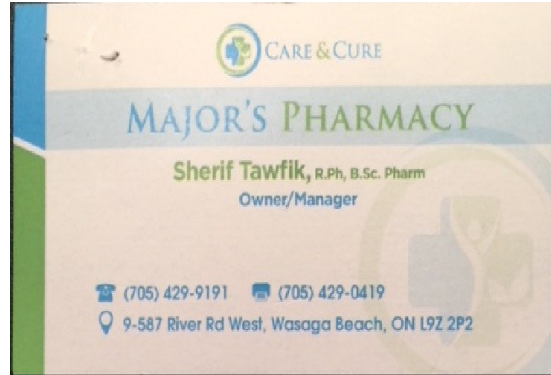
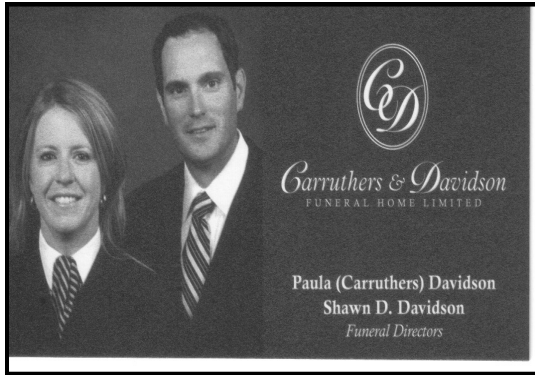
*Instead, millions of flowers are grown around the world and shipped specifically for February 14th.*
