THE KEEP FIT KORNER

The shoes you wear should do a lot more than get you from Point A to Point B. A good pair should make you feel better and can protect you from falls, a leading cause of injury-related hospitalizations among older adults. Consider the following when choosing sneakers and shoes:

- A wide rubber sole with treads** – more sole contact with the ground increases stability, and treads provide traction.
- A medium-firm insole** – test firmness by pressing on the heel of the shoe's bottom; it shouldn't be too hard or too soft.
- A stiffer upper** – look for footwear with a somewhat rigid upper, especially around the back of the foot, to hug your foot for better balance.

SQUATS: not the most fun thing to do but necessary and here's why: Squats are a compound exercise that activates numerous muscles simultaneously. The benefits? Better balance, better flexibility, better posture, and better lower body strength – all issues that impact aging well.

Squats ... help keep our core muscles strong as they engage our abdominal and lower back muscles ... help our body perform daily tasks like bending down to pick something up off the floor ... help improve balance and better balance leads to less falls, and puts pressure on the bones to help slow down bone loss as we age.

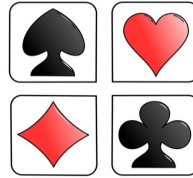

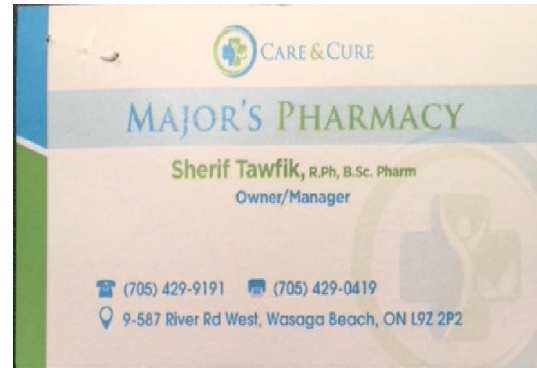
